

## **St. Luke's Travel Medicine Clinic Instructions**

1. Students are required to spend four half-days in the Travel Medicine clinic. These should be four uninterrupted hours during which the student does not have other responsibilities. If the clinic rotation coincides with the ID elective, the clinics should generally be scheduled in the morning to avoid conflict with attending rounds. The clinics can be scheduled at other times providing the student does not have concomitant responsibilities.
2. Students are requested to notify St. Luke's Travel Medicine clinic at least two weeks prior to their chosen month of rotation. Please provide name, daytime phone number and e-mail address. 3. Students may arrange their Travel Medicine clinic schedule on a week-to-week basis once they begin the rotation. The entire month does not need to be scheduled in advance.
4. Students are expected to be actively involved in the Travel Medicine clinic activities (reviewing itineraries, researching destination requirements, and, if desired, counseling travelers and administering vaccines). Readings are assigned and a take-home quiz is given.
5. St. Luke's Travel Medicine clinic is located at 2457 S. Braeswood, St. Luke's Diagnostic and Treatment Center-Kirby Glen, at the intersection of Kirby and S. Braeswood. Clinic hours are 8am-4:30pm Monday through Friday. The Travel Medicine clinic phone number is 832-355-8222.
