RSV continues to be the most common virus detected in December, followed by hMPV, picornaviruses (enteroviruses and rhinoviruses), and adenovirus. Small numbers of both influenza A and B, as well as all the types of parainfluenza, were also detected. Look for influenza to increase next month!


