The Neonatology Section must receive written notification of a cancellation or refund request postmarked no later than 10 business days prior to the scheduled program date. A \$50 fee will be deducted from the registration fee paid to cover processing charges. Late requests will not be processed. The Neonatology Section reserves the right to conduct its courses based on a minimum enrollment and to cancel courses not less than 10 business days prior to the scheduled program date if low enrollment or other circumstances make it necessary. 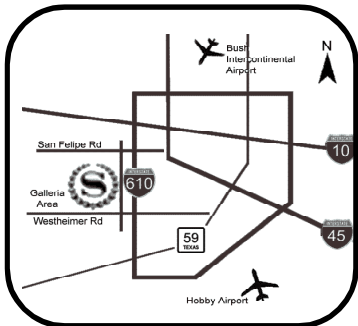
