

ROUX-EN-Y GASTRIC BYPASS SURGERY

In Roux-en-Y Gastric Bypass, our surgeons separate the upper portion of the stomach from the lower portion creating a "pouch" that connects to the small intestine. The food will now bypass, or skip the rest of the stomach and a portion of the small intestine. The new pouch limits the amount of food that you will consume, thus making you feel full after a small portion of food. This leads to weight loss without stress because you will not be as hungry as before surgery.

WHY BAYLOR HOSPITAL GASTRIC BYPASS SURGERY?

At Baylor, we understand that improving health through weight loss can be a challenge and we are here to help! This procedure is done by making several small incisions and a camera to guide the surgery (commonly known as laparoscopic approach). The surgical robot can also be used. This operation usually takes about two to three hours. Patients typically stay in the hospital for one or two nights.
