

Candidates applying for admission are asked to submit the following:

✓ **Application Form**

Only completed applications with ALL required documentation will be reviewed.

✓ **Curriculum Vitae**

An outline of your educational and professional experience.

✓ **Personal Statement**

An essay to provide additional evidence of your intellectual interests and creative achievement.

✓ **Graduate School Transcript***

For reviewing purposes, electronic copies of transcripts from each university and/or medical school that you have attended may be submitted to meet the application requirements.

Individuals that have earned doctoral degrees or who have received medical training outside of the U.S., Canada, or Puerto Rico, may need to meet additional requirements. Candidates are strongly urged to have the ABMGG Credentials Committee review their credentials to determine transfer equivalency of their doctoral degree prior to applying for medical genetics training in an ABMGG-accredited fellowship. ✓ **GRE/TOEFL***

Electronic copies of each examination should be uploaded to your application for evaluation.

BCM requires all applicants to provide a GRE (Graduate Record Examination) General Test score report for review. GRE Subject test is recommended but not required.

The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is required of any student whose native language is not English. The TOEFL and the IELTS are not required for US Citizens, nor for international students who earned a degree from a university in which English is the official language of communication.

✓ **Letters of recommendation**

At least three letters of recommendation are required and one should be from your current PI. The online application system will require you to submit your recommender's names and email addresses. The system will then send an automated email to each of your references with a secure link to the online system, allowing them to submit letters on your behalf.

(*) NOTE: Official transcripts and original exam reports will be required ONLY if you are offered admission to BCM.
