As a Clinical Ethics Fellow, you will:

- Receive comprehensive training in clinical ethics consultation, including the opportunity to observe and independently conduct ethics consultations for a high-volume Clinical Ethics Consultation Service (~400 consultations per year) at the Houston Methodist Hospital
- Participate in Biomedical Ethics Committee and subcommittee meetings
- Participate in educational activities related to our undergraduate and graduate medical curricula; including the award-winning medical ethics pathway
- Deliver presentations on clinical ethics-related topics for clinical audiences
- Be mentored by our Faculty on educational development, teaching skills, and research
- Have opportunities for collaboration on scholarly projects and participation in activities at Baylor College of Medicine affiliate hospitals
