Charge

The Curriculum Committee has the institutional responsibility for the overall design, management and evaluation of a coherent and coordinated medical education curriculum, which is codified by decanal mandate;

The Committee governs all aspects of the curricular content and means of student assessment;

The Committee has the responsibility and authority to make necessary changes in the curriculum to meet Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) standards and to ensure that the students fulfill the Core Competency Graduation Goals (CCGGs);

The Curriculum Committee conducts formal systematic review of the Core Competency Graduation Goals (CCGGs) and the curriculum as a whole at least every two years to identify and implement needed revisions, and it tasks several subcommittees to gather and review data on an ongoing basis and to make recommendations to the Curriculum Committee for consideration and action, as needed.
