



Students: Baseline Photo Setup

This document serves as instructions to help students with setting up a baseline photo.

- If you are a returning student, update Examplify to version 2.3.12.
 If you are a new student, install Examplify version 2.3.12.
- 2. Launch Examplify and register to reach the dashboard.

3. After downloading your exam, you should see the ExamID and ExamMonitor boxes, indicating these features are enabled for this exam.

- 4. If you do not see the ExamID and ExamMonitor boxes, perform steps **a f** below. If you see the boxes, proceed to step 5.
 - a. Remove the exam download select the blue text below the exam password and follow the prompts
 - b. Select the home menu towards the top-right
 - c. Select the settings
 - d. Select to clear the registration
 - e. Re-launch Examplify and login
 - f. Re-download the exam
- 5. <u>Important baseline info</u>: before you enter the exam password, ensure you are in a location where no one else will be included in the baseline photo you are about to take. The baseline photo should be clear, in a well-lit area, and with only your headshot in frame (example below). It is critical that the baseline is setup accurately as this will be photoverified for future exams moving forward. *Note: this must be a live photo, not a photo id.*



6. Enter the exam password provided by your instructor, which will launch a welcome to ExamID message.





7. After selecting to get started, you'll look to consent to the collection of biometric data.



8. Once you consent, you'll see an Allow Media Device Access screen. It is at this time when Examplify checks your device to ensure the appropriate media settings are enabled. If you do not encounter an error, as seen below to the left, select Next and proceed to step 9. If you encounter an error, as seen below to the right, please refer to the resource links below.


Once camera & microphone errors are resolved, select Refresh, then Next.

- 9. After your baseline is setup, proceed to complete the exam.
- 10. When you submit, you'll see an upload screen with checkboxes.



11. Your answer file will be prepared and uploaded as usual, then you'll see a new green screen. This indicates your answer file has been uploaded and your monitoring files are currently uploading. At this point, you can return to the dashboard.



- 12. Please leave your device powered on and connected to the internet to allow your monitoring files to upload. You can close Examplify and your monitoring files will continue to upload in the background.
- 13. Congratulations, your baseline is all set and will now be photo-verified for future exams!
