Goals and Objectives

Goal 1: HPM fellows will learn and practice the fundamental skills of narrative medicine via close reading of literature, poetry, essays and personal writing. Medical Knowledge, Interpersonal Communication Skills

Objectives:

- 1. Define narrative medicine and describe close reading
- 2. Write a reflection based on each month's close reading prompt
- 3. Apply close reading to reflective writing

Goal 2: HPM Fellows will use narrative medicine skills in patient encounters to build positive patientphysician relationships. Patient Care, Systems Based Practice

Objectives:

- 1. Recognize the purpose and elements of parallel charting
- 2. Apply parallel charting to a recorded simulated patient encounter
- 3. Analyze parallel chart and recorded encounter using close reading

Goal 3: HPM Fellows will use narrative medicine skills to cultivate healthy professional development practices. Practice Based Learning, Professionalism

Objectives:

- 1. Identify personal signs and symptoms of burnout through reflective writing and close reading
- 2. Create a personal resilience prescription to mitigate burnout and maintain resilience
- 3. Examine professional identity formation in personal career trajectory
